## THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020

## Regulations made by the Minister under section 13 of the Quarantine Act 2020

- These regulations may be cited as the Consolidated COVID-19 (Amendment No. 4) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations —

"principal regulations" means the Consolidated COVID-19 Regulations 2021.

**3.** Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (1) and replacing it by the following paragraph —

(1) A person referred to in regulation 10 shall, subject to paragraph (2), be selfconfined for a period of at least 7 days from the day he has been tested to be infected with COVID-19.

- **4.** The Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph 1, by deleting the words "10 days" and replacing them by the words "7 days".
- **5.** These regulations shall come into operation on 19 February 2022.
