THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020

Regulations made by the Minister under section 13 of the Quarantine Act 2020

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consolidated COVID-19 (Amendment No. 5) Regulations 2021**.

2. In these regulations —

"principal regulations" means the Consolidated COVID-19 Regulations 2021.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definitions —

"booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine" means, in the case of a person who has been vaccinated with —

- (a) one dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine, an additional dose of any other COVID-19 vaccine to that of the one dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine; or
- (b) two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, other than the 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine referred to in paragraph (a), an additional dose of any other COVID-19 vaccine to that of the 2 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine;

"fully vaccinated" —

- (a) means a person who is vaccinated with a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine, provided that the booster dose is administered 4 months, but not later than 6 months, after the administration of the first dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine or second dose of any other COVID-19 vaccine, as the case may be; and
- (b) includes a person who has, further to being tested as being infected with COVID-19, recovered therefrom, provided that 4 months have not lapsed after the date of the test; or
- (c) includes a person who has, further to being tested as being infected with COVID-19, recovered therefrom and has, 4 months after the date of the test, been administered with a dose of COVID-19 vaccine, provided that 14 days have lapsed after such administration;

4. The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 9.

5. Regulation 13 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (1)(a)(i)(A), by deleting the words "vaccinated with at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine" and replacing them by the words "fully vaccinated".

6. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (2) —

(a) in subparagraph (a)(i), by deleting the words "vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine" and replacing them by the words "fully vaccinated";

(b) in subparagraph (b)(i), by deleting the words "vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine" and replacing them by the words "fully vaccinated".

7. These regulations shall come into operation on 15 January 2022.
