Statistics on HIV/AIDS (as at end of December 2020)

From October to December 2020, a total of 80 new cases of HIV/AIDS were registered among the Mauritian population by the Virology Laboratory Services of the Ministry of Health and Wellness. The monthly average of new cases decreased from 46 in the period 2006 - 2010 to 26 in the period 2011 – 2016. However, for 2017 - 2019, the monthly average went up to 31. For the year 2020, it was 27. A decrease in the number of tests, probably due to Covid-19 pandemic, may partly explain the significant decrease registered in 2020.

The number of cases reported during the last 12 months is given in Table A.

The yearly average positivity rate of HIV tests carried out at the Virology Laboratory, which fluctuated between 0.41% and 0.46% in the period 2016-2019, was 0.42% for 2020. However, the number of tests carried in 2020 was 80,370, indicating a 17% decrease compared to the number of tests in 2019.

Distribution of new cases of HIV/AIDS among Mauritians by age-group – 2010-2020



The yearly number of new cases reported among Mauritians since 2005 is given in Table B. The decreasing trend observed from 2011 to 2015 was reversed in 2016 whereby the number of new cases increased from 319 in 2016 to 368 and 382 in 2017 and 2018 respectively. However, in 2019, it slightly decreased to 374. The 2020 figure of 318 new cases cannot be used to determine the trend. The cumulative total since October 1987, when the first case of HIV/AIDS was reported, to December 2020 stood at 8,113.

Since 1987, of all Mauritian HIV/AIDS cases, 59.6% was detected among people who inject drug (PWID). In 2019, it was 29.9% compared to 35.1% in 2015. For the year 2020, it stood at 22%. On the other hand, the proportion of new cases detected among heterosexual, which had increased from 52.3% in 2015 to 61.5% in 2019, was 64.8% in 2020.
