Statistics on HIV/AIDS (as at end of December 2022)

From January to December 2022, a total of 391 new cases of HIV/AIDS were registered among the Mauritian population by the Virology Laboratory Services of the Ministry of Health and Wellness. The monthly average of new cases decreased from 46 in the period 2006 - 2010 to 26 in the period 2011 – 2016. However, for 2017 - 2019, it went up to 31. In the year 2020 and 2021, the monthly average was 27 equally. In 2022, it has increased to 33.

The number of cases reported during the last 12 months is given in the table below.

The yearly number of new cases reported in Mauritius since 2010 is detailed in the above table. The decreasing trend observed in the period 2011 to 2015 was reversed in 2016. The average number of new cases among Mauritians in the period 2017 to 2019 was 375. In 2020 and 2021, the number of new cases decreased to 318 and 327 respectively most probably due to the decrease in the number of tests. However, following the increase in the number of tests in 2022, the number of newly detected cases among Mauritians has gone up to 391. The cumulative total since October 1987, when the first case of HIV/AIDS was reported, as at end of 2022 stood at 8,831.
