Statistics on HIV/AIDS (as at end of December 2014)

During the month of December 2014, 23 new cases of HIV/AIDS were registered among the Mauritian population by the Virology Laboratory Services of the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life. The monthly average of new cases was 46 in the year 2006 to 2010 compared to 27 in the period 2011 – 2013; in 2014, the figure stood at 27 equally, indicating a stabilization in the trend.

The yearly number of cases reported among Mauritians since 2004 is given in Table B. Between 2004 and 2010, an average of 545 cases has been registered every year except in 2005 when 921 cases were reported mainly among prison inmates. 401 cases have been registered in 2011 compared to 568 in 2010. A yearly average of 327 cases have been registered in the period 2011-2013 compared to 322 in 2014. The cumulative total since October 1987, when the first case of HIV/AIDS was reported, to December 2014, stood at 6,090.

Since 1987, of all Mauritian HIV/AIDS cases, 68.9% of transmission was due to injecting drug. In the year 2000, only 2% of the new infected cases were among Injecting Drug Users (IDU). This mode of transmission rapidly increased from 7% in 2001 to 92% in 2005; it then started to decrease and was 47.2% in 2012. In 2014, it stood at 31.1% compared to 38.1% in 2013.
