Statistics on HIV/AIDS (as at end of June 2018)

During the month of June 2018, 31 new cases of HIV/AIDS were registered among the Mauritian population by the Virology Laboratory Services of the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life. The monthly average of new cases was 46 in the year 2006 to 2010 compared to 26 in the period 2011 – 2015. For the year 2016, the monthly average was 27 cases compared to 31 for the year of 2017. For the period January to June 2018, the monthly average is 32. The number of cases reported during the last 12 months is given in Table A.

In 2016 and 2017, increases in the number of new cases of HIV/AIDS have been registered in all age-groups except in that of 40-54 years.

The yearly number of cases reported among Mauritians since 2005 is given in Table B. A yearly average of 314 cases has been registered in the period 2011-2016. In 2017, 368 cases have been reported. The cumulative total since October 1987, when the first case of HIV/AIDS was reported, to June 2018, stood at 7,230.

Since 1987, of all Mauritian HIV/AIDS cases, 63.7% was detected among people who inject drug (PWID). In the year 2000, only 2% of the new infected cases were among this group, after which the yearly percentage rapidly increased to 92% in 2005. In 2017, it was 38.6% compared to 32.6% in 2016. For January to June 2018, it was 35.1%.
