• New Cases


From January to June 2023, a total of 182 new cases of HIV/AIDS were registered among the Mauritian population by the Virology Laboratory Services of the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

• Monthly Average

The monthly average of new cases during the first six months of 2023 stood at 30 compared to 31 during the same period in 2022. The monthly average number of new cases detected during the period 2011 to 2023 is depicted in the Chart below.

The positivity rate of HIV tests, which was 0.44% equally in 2021 and 2022, went down to 0.39% in the period January to June 2023.

• Distribution of new cases of HIV/AIDS among Mauritians by age-group

34.1% of the new cases of HIV among Mauritians in the first six months of 2023 were among those aged between 25-39 years followed by those in the age group 40-54 years with 31.9%. A breakdown by age group since 2013 is provided in the table below.

• Total Number of cases

The first case of HIV/AIDS in the Republic of Mauritius was notified in October 1987. During the period 1987-2009, 4,396 new cases were registered with 4,219 cases among Mauritians. The yearly number of cases recorded since 2010 is detailed in the table that follows.

The decreasing trend observed in the period 2011 to 2015 was reversed in 2016. The average number of new cases among Mauritians in the period 2017 to 2019 was 375. In 2020 and 2021, the number of new cases decreased to 318 and 327 respectively most probably due to the decrease in the number of tests. However, following the increase in the number of tests in 2022, the number of newly detected cases among Mauritians has gone up to 391. The cumulative total (Mauritians only) since October 1987 to end of June 2023 stood at 9,013 in the Republic of Mauritius.
