2. We wish to inform you that your offer for the **Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Vehicles for the Ministry of Health and Wellness** as per Annex A, for the total amount of **Rs 17,500,000.00 (Rupees Seventeen Million and Five Hundred Thousand only)**, inclusive of all applicable charges, duties and taxes and exclusive of VAT, subject to the terms and conditions and specifications of the bidding documents and extracts as per annex, has been approved.

3. The vehicles should be delivered <sup>04 July 2025</sup> **within twelve (12) weeks** as from the date of this Letter of Acceptance, to the Senior Manager, Ministry of Health and Wellness, Department of Operations Support Services, Pointe aux Sables Road, GRNW. The Senior Manager, Operations Support Services, Mr Gowreesunkur, should be informed prior to delivery on Tel No. 234 4850.

4. Warranty shall be provided as follows:

- (i) Item 1 – Three (3) years or 100,000 km, as from the date of successful commissioning of the vehicle;
- (ii) Item 3 – One (1) year on all parts and labour, as from the date of successful commissioning of the vehicle.

5. The Commissioning Certificate must be signed by a representative from the User Department, the Mechanical Engineer and your representative.

6. **Liquidated damages for delays, if any, will be charged at the rate of 0.5% per day of delay. The maximum amount of liquidated damages shall be 5% of the final contract price.**

7. You should provide, free of charge, local training as per the conditions of offer.

8. Goods Form 1 will be drawn by the Procurement and Supply Section of Department of Operations Support Services, upon confirmation by user department that the vehicles have been delivered, tested and commissioned satisfactorily and are in good running condition. Payment will be then effected by the Finance Section of the Ministry and will be credited to your Bank Account after signature of Goods Form 1.

9. The following documents, in original, should consequently be submitted to the Procurement and Supply Section of the Ministry for payment purposes:

- (i) Duly signed Goods Form 1;
- (ii) Duly signed original delivery note(s);
- (iii) Original Invoice(s);
- (iv) Warranty certificates- Three copies;
- (v) Commissioning certificates – Three copies; and
- (vi) Your bank name, address and bank account number.

10. You are requested to submit within <sup>09 May 2025</sup> **twenty-eight (28) days**, as from the date of this letter, a Performance Security representing 10% of the contract value in the form of a Bank/ Insurance Guarantee issued by a Commercial Bank/ Insurance Company operating in Mauritius. The Performance Security should be valid for a period of twenty-eight (28) days beyond the commissioning period and should be submitted to the **Registry Section, Procurement Unit, Ministry of Health and Wellness, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, NexSky Building, Hotel Avenue, Cybercity, Ebene**. However, in the event of delay in the delivery and/or commissioning of the vehicles, you shall extend this Security for the period mentioned above. Failure to submit the required **Performance Security** within the prescribed time limit shall result in an automatic cancellation of the Award. No item(s) will be accepted prior to submission of a valid Performance Security.
