3. The contract shall be for a period of **thirty-six (36) months** and shall be inclusive of labour and transport. However, no subsequent offer or any claims for labour and/or transport shall be entertained throughout the duration of the contract. The intended start date for the commencement of the services shall be **11 November 2025**, renewable thereafter on an annual basis subject to satisfactory performance for a further period of two years.
4. **Liquidated damage for any delay will be charged at the rate of 0.5% per day of the value of undelivered items for the services.** The maximum amount of liquidated damage per lot is **10 percent of the Contract Price for the respective year.**
5. **Payment will be effected on a monthly basis** after receipt of complete invoice and accompanying documents as required by the User Department after confirmation that the cleaning services have been effected satisfactorily as per the scope of services. All documentations including claims should be addressed to the Regional Health Services Administrator or his /her representatives of the respective regions/sites. You are therefore requested to contact the latter for coordination and follow up of the service.
6. You are requested to submit within **twenty-one (21) days** as from date of this letter a **Performance Security** representing 5% of the contract value for year 1 issued by a Commercial bank/Insurance Company operating in Mauritius. The Performance Security should be valid for a period of **twenty-eight (28) days beyond the contractual period** and should be submitted to the Officer-in-Charge, Procurement Registry, Ministry of Health and Wellness, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Nexsky Building, Hotel Avenue, Cybercity, Ebène.

#### WHEREAS

- a) the Employer has requested the Service Provider to provide certain Services known as **"Procurement of Laundry Services for Hospital Clothing for a period of thirty-six (36) months for Health Region 5: Victoria Hospital"** – file references - **MHPQ/WKS&S/2025-2026/Q7** and **MHPDO/WKS&S/2025-2026/DO11** as defined in the General Conditions of Contract attached to this Contract (hereinafter called the "Services" and the remedying of any defects therein);

## 2. Payment Terms


Payments shall be made according to the following schedule:
