General Notice No. 647 of 2026

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 78 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT

WHEREAS section 78 of the Public Health Act provides that where any part of Mauritius appears to be threatened with, or is infected by, any dangerous epidemic, endemic, infectious or communicable disease, the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, direct that sections 79 to 83 shall be applicable in –

- (a) Mauritius; or
- (b) such area of Mauritius as may be specified in the notice.

2. NOW THEREFORE, in view of the fact that the World Health Organisation has, on 16 May 2026, declared the outbreak of Ebola Virus Disease in Democratic Republic of the Congo and Uganda as a public health emergency of international concern and Mauritius is threatened with such communicable disease, I do hereby direct that sections 79 to 83 shall be applicable in Mauritius.

General Notice No. 648 of 2026

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4(1) OF THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020

WHEREAS section 4(1) of the Quarantine Act 2020 provides that where the Minister considers that it is necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread in Mauritius of a communicable disease, he shall, by notice published in the Gazette, declare that –

- (a) there is or is likely to be an epidemic of the disease; and
- (b) a quarantine period shall be in force in Mauritius, or part thereof, as from such date as may be specified in the notice.

2. NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the fact that I am satisfied that it is necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread of Ebola Virus Disease in Mauritius, I do hereby declare that –

- (a) there is likely to be an epidemic of Ebola Virus Disease; and
- (b) a quarantine period shall be in force in Mauritius from 9 June 2026 to 7 August 2026.
