General Notice No. 907 of 2026

**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 4(1) OF
THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020**

WHEREAS section 4(1) of the Quarantine Act 2020 provides that where the Minister considers that it is necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread in Mauritius of a communicable disease, he shall, by notice published in the Gazette, declare that –

- (a) there is or is likely to be an epidemic of the disease; and
 - (b) a quarantine period shall be in force in Mauritius, or part thereof, as from such date as may be specified in the notice.
- 2. WHEREAS** in view of the fact that I was satisfied that it was necessary and expedient to

prevent the introduction and spread of Ebola Virus Disease in Mauritius, I declared, by virtue of General Notice No. 648 of 2026, that –

- (a) there is likely to be an epidemic of Ebola Virus Disease; and
- (b) a quarantine period shall be in force in Mauritius from 8 June 2026 to 7 August 2026.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the fact that I am still satisfied that it is necessary and expedient to prevent the introduction and spread of Ebola Virus Disease in Mauritius, I hereby extend the quarantine period to 7 September 2026.
